



Greenhills Camp Code of Conduct Policy

At Greenhills Camp, we have a code of conduct policy that outlines the expected behaviour of all campers and staff members. This policy is designed to ensure a safe and respectful environment for everyone and to promote positive interactions and experiences at camp.

Our code of conduct policy includes:

1. Respect for self and others - treating others with kindness, empathy, and respect; using appropriate language and avoiding derogatory comments, insults, or physical aggression.
2. Respect for property - taking care of camp facilities and equipment, respecting the natural environment, and not damaging or defacing camp property.
3. Safety - following all safety rules and procedures, not engaging in dangerous behaviour, and reporting any unsafe situations to camp staff.

4. Responsibility - taking responsibility for personal belongings and actions, being accountable for one's choices, and following camp rules and procedures.
5. Honesty - being truthful in all interactions, avoiding lying, cheating, or stealing, and reporting any incidents that may require intervention or disciplinary action.
6. Inclusivity - promoting an inclusive and welcoming environment for all campers and staff, respecting diversity, and avoiding discrimination or harassment.
7. Compliance - following all camp policies and procedures, including those related to behaviour, communication, and supervision.

Violations of the code of conduct policy may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to verbal warnings, loss of privileges, time-outs, or early dismissal from camp. We believe that everyone has the right to enjoy a safe and respectful environment at camp, and our code of conduct policy is designed to support this goal.
