



Greenhills Camp Discipline and Consequences Policy

At Greenhills Camp, we have clear guidelines in place for appropriate behaviour, and consequences for inappropriate behaviour. We believe that clear and consistent discipline is essential to maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment for all our campers and staff. Our discipline and consequences policy includes the following measures:

1. **Clear Expectations:** We set clear expectations for camper behaviour and have guidelines in place for appropriate conduct. These guidelines are communicated to campers and their families when they register their child/ren, and we reinforce them regularly throughout the camp session.
2. **Consequences for Inappropriate Behaviour:** We have a range of consequences for inappropriate behaviour, depending on the severity of the behaviour. These consequences include verbal warnings, time-outs, loss of privileges, and, in rare cases, expulsion from camp.

3. Fairness and Consistency: We enforce our guidelines and consequences fairly and consistently, without discrimination or favoritism.
4. Positive Reinforcement: We use positive reinforcement to encourage positive behavior, including praising and recognising campers who display positive behaviour, and providing incentives for good behaviour.

We believe that our discipline and consequences policy is essential to maintaining a safe and enjoyable environment for all our campers and staff. By enforcing our guidelines and consequences fairly and consistently, we create a culture of respect and positive behaviour that encourages campers to be their best selves. Our policy is designed to promote positive behaviour and ensure that everyone at camp feels safe, respected, and supported.
