Policy Regarding Children with SNAs Attending Greenhills Summer Camp

At Greenhills Summer Camp, we are committed to providing a safe and inclusive environment for all children. We recognise that some children may require additional support due to having Special Needs Assistants (SNAs) or carers in their school setting. In order to accommodate these children while ensuring their safety and well-being, the following policy has been established:

1. **Assessment of Suitability:** Parents or guardians of children with SNAs or carers who wish to attend Greenhills Summer Camp must first assess whether our camp is suitable for their child's needs. It is important to note that our camp is highly stimulating and physically demanding, which may not be suitable for all children.

2. **Safety Considerations:** Greenhills Summer Camp is an open environment with various activities, and it may pose risks to children who are flight risks or require constant supervision. Therefore, any child who has an SNA or carer in school will need to have one present at our camp to ensure their safety and the safety of others.
3. **Additional Support Fee:** Parents or guardians of children requiring an SNA or carer at Greenhills Summer Camp will be required to pay an additional fee. This fee will cover half of the SNA's weekly wage. Greenhills Summer Camp will cover the other half of the SNA's weekly wage. However, it is important to note that this arrangement is subject to finding a fully qualified SNA who can provide the necessary support for the child.
4. **Application Process:** Parents or guardians interested in enrolling their child with an SNA or carer at Greenhills Summer Camp must notify us during the registration process. They will be required to provide relevant documentation regarding their child's needs and the support required.
5. **Assessment and Approval:** Upon receiving the necessary information, our team will assess the suitability of our camp for the child and determine whether we can provide the required support. This assessment will consider factors such as the availability of qualified SNAs and the camp's capacity to meet the child's needs.
6. **Continued Communication:** Throughout the camp period, we will maintain open communication with parents or guardians, as well as the child's SNA or carer, to ensure that the child's needs are being met effectively.

At Greenhills Summer Camp, we are dedicated to creating an inclusive and supportive environment for all children. By adhering to this policy, we aim to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for children with SNAs or carers, allowing them to participate fully in our camp activities.

This policy is subject to review and may be updated as necessary to ensure compliance with best practices and regulations regarding the provision of support for children with additional needs.
